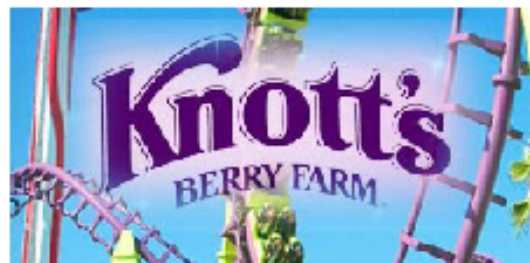

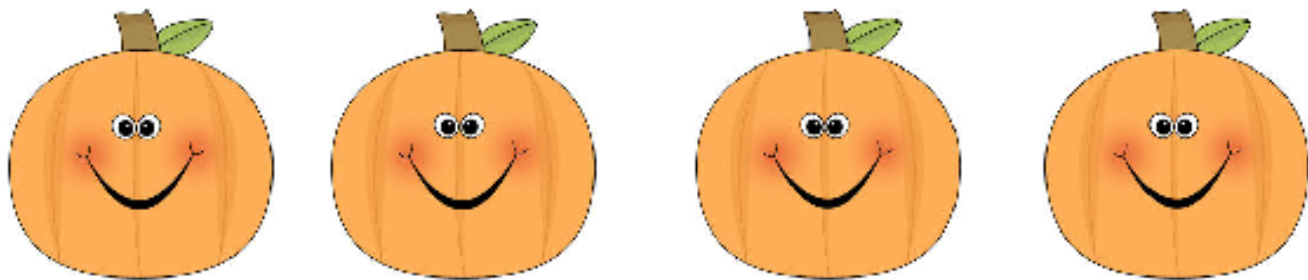
PRE-ORDER TICKET SALE
